Then the information will not be given and the employer will be referred to the employee.</p> <p>The employee can issue a statement (through e-mail or telephone) to declare that the employer will look after their interests.</p>

		Verification	Article 6 lid 1 sub c. Also: article 6 lid 1 sub f, An employer should be able to look after the interests of the employee, in order for them to do their job.	Kiwa should be able to inform businesses about validity of licenses or permits of their employees, so that they can do their job. It is therefore in the interest of both the employee and the employer that the first is able to verify the validity of the latter's document. Kiwa Register only answers verification questions by saying "is valid and issued by us". New personal data is thereby not shared.

ILT's task is upholding the laws and regulations concerned with seafarer transportation. Certain personal data that is processed by Kiwa Register is needed for this purpose.

		Verification	Article 6 lid 1 sub c.	Kmar and the police are allowed to request information on grounds of: kader van handhaving en opsporing .
	Foreign institutions	Verification and substantive information about documents	Article 6 lid 1 sub c	Verifying licenses and permits is mandated by law (STCW). Kiwa sends copies of foreign documents and will receive copies of Dutch documents. This is applicable both in and out of Europe.

Other	Friend/family/ partner	Status	Article 6 lid 1 sub f	In certain cases it may be useful/necessary for a partner, family member or friend to submit the application. Kiwa Register should be able to inform them about the status of the application. Verification questions like date of birth or application number will be asked.
